Selectmen's Meeting March 1, 2022

5:30pm the meeting was called to order by Chair, William Flynn.

Minutes of February 22nd were approved by Bill; seconded by Dick. Vote 3-0-0.

Recreation Department – Willy reports they are working on extending the basketball season. The snowmobile club has partnered with the rec department and they will be hosting a community sledding party on March 13th. Baseball signups will be starting soon.

Community Center – Willy reports Federal Piping is requesting a final inspection; Willy said some items still need attention. Ricky and Dick will meet tomorrow morning to do a walk through with Willy. Willy stated that some other areas of the building need to be improved/repaired; the gym doors have no glass in the windows and the carpet is starting to bunch up, causing a tripping hazard.

Transfer Station Loads – The Board unanimously decided to continue sending loads to Mt Carberry for another week. Bill asked it to be placed on the next agenda.

Deb Tait/John Hicks – Deb asked the Board some questions regarding ACO budget/training and if other towns that she works for contribute to her training fees; they do not. Deb read "a formal request of the Selectmen to place the voted recommendations of the budget committee for all requests as recorded in the budget committee minutes on the town warrant for the next annual town meeting." Ricky motioned to accept Deb's request for this year's warrant only; seconded by Dick. Vote 2-1-0.

Comprehensive Plan – Deb stated that she overnighted the plan to the state today. She also asked about having a special town meeting – as such a large document will likely extend the annual town meeting to a very late end time.

Transfer Station Footprint – Bill referenced the sketch of the proposed changes at the transfer station; he will update the footprint to reflect these changes once they are made and add the "hot loads" area to the footprint as well.
