Selectmen's Meeting January 7, 2020

5:36pm the meeting was called to order by Chair, William Flynn.

Minutes of December 31<sup>st</sup> were approved by Erik; seconded by Ricky. Vote 3-0-0.

**Public Works Department** – Brian reports two trucks plow wings broke during the last storm; they were able to repair them and put them back on. They have mostly been doing road cleaning/sanding and truck repairs.

**Fire Department** – Dickie reports 1 chimney fire, 3 motor vehicle accidents, 3 medical assists and 1 citizen assist. He has started to work on his sign order. The Fire Department voted to purchase a 6'x10' enclosed trailer. He received his SHAPE plaque that is valid until October 2022. Dickie said that he is trying to coordinate the repair of one of the BCC fire alarm pulls that was broken when a child pulled the alarm. Erik made a motion to expend money from the building reserve account to repair the fire alarm pull; seconded by Bill. Vote 3-0-0.

**Sam Brown Hill Road Bridge** – Linda P asked Brian for an update on the bridge; Brian reports that HEB is putting it out to bid January 11<sup>th</sup> with a completion date of May 29<sup>th</sup> 2020.

**Salvation Army Drop Boxes** – Bill has spoken with the Salvation Army about moving the drop boxes to the transfer station due to the increasing number of unusable items being dropped off (mattresses, car seats, etc). Items will be able to be dropped off at the transfer station on Wednesdays, Saturdays and Sundays. The tentative date of the boxes being moved is February 1<sup>st</sup> and the Salvation Army will change their pick up day from Tuesday to Wednesday.

**Food Scraps / Composting** – Erik motioned to continuing using AgriCycle while we look into another compost company/option for food scraps; seconded by Ricky. Vote 3-0-0.

**Brownfield Days** – Bill reports that he has spoken with LifeFlight – they are willing to come to Brownfield Days at some capacity. Megan and Michelle will fill out the request form.
