5:30pm the meeting was called to order by Chair, William Flynn.

Minutes of January 25th were approved by Bill; seconded by Dick. Vote 3-0-0.

Dana Batchelder – Dana asked the board about continuing his mowing contract, as it expires this year. He knows that we will be asking for bids on the cemeteries as well. The Board suggested that he get a list of the cemeteries and do a site visit when the snow is gone and place a bid when we begin accepting them.

Bishop Farms Subdivision – Dorothy and Greg Gardiner came to the Board to request that the town takes over the care/maintenance of the fire suppression tank within their subdivision. They feel that because it can be used by the fire department for any home, they should not be responsible for the tank. Dickie explained that all other newer (within 25 years or so) subdivisions are required to have the same and that it was part of their covenants on their deed when they purchased the home. The Board asked Megan to reach out to our attorney on this matter.

Community Center Boiler – Mike stated that he did a walk though with Federal Piping – the boiler has been fired and heat is working in most areas. There are a few things left that need to be completed/fixed; Megan will email Federal to get a price on the additional work.
