Selectmen's Meeting June 9, 2020

Attendees: Dickie Perreault, Michelle Day, Gene Bergofen, Vincent Carbone

5:30pm the meeting was called to order by Chair, William Flynn.

Minutes of June 2nd were approved by Bill; seconded by Erik. Vote 3-0-0.

Community Garden – Vincent Carbone asked about the possibility of having a community garden. The Board advised him to put together a rough idea for his plans and see Megan about being put on an upcoming agenda.

Annual Town Meeting – As of now, the Governor has limited gatherings of only 50 people. In the event that more than 50 people come to Town Meeting on July 15th, the meeting would be postponed to September 9th. It will be recommended that people attending wear masks, but there will be a section designated for those who do not wear one. Gene Bergofen asked if we could have two separate microphones, one for him to use and another for residents. The meeting will be at the Town garage to allow for better social distancing and more open space.

Town Office Opening – Michelle stated that her plan is to reopen the Clerk's office back to full hours beginning June 16th. There will be no Saturday's as of right now. She has been cleaning all surfaces every hour, or if someone requests it to be done.

Transfer Station tire tickets – There was discussion about the current tire tickets that residents receive when registering a vehicle. There were recently some tickets turned in that were 15+ years old based on the style of the ticket. Erik made a motion that beginning July 1, 2020 we will begin using a new ticket system that will have an expiration date of 1 year from the vehicle registration; seconded by Bill. Vote 3-0-0.

Recreation Director Letter – Bill made a motion to send a thank you letter to Frank Day for all of his years of service to the Town; seconded by Erik. Vote 3-0-0.

Selectmen's Meeting Policy – Bill referenced the Selectmen's meeting policy dated 10/11/2006. Erik motioned to do rescind the current policy; seconded by Bill. Vote 3-0-0. Megan will draft a new policy for the Board's review.
