Chairman, Dick Norcross called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM.

Dick motioned, John second to approve the Minutes of November 14, 2023.

The Board approved the Marijuana Fee Schedule after reviewing Planning Board's suggestions.

CMP offers to convert our street lights to LED if the Town will sign a new 15-year lease agreement at no "extra cost" but would switch the lights out and then update our billing to the new LED rates. The Board agreed to ask for more information on the new rate.

The Winter Sand Use Policy was read by Frank. Discussion of the policy was to allow people to get sand and not misuse it. The Board agreed that the policy is to allow (3) five-gallon buckets and the policy will be clarified. Bruce said he only wanted it to be clear.

Dick, John, and Frank presented Della Smith with the Boston Post Cane as Brownfield's Oldest Citizen. She asked if she can keep it if it was on loan, Dick said that when she doesn't need it any more, it comes back.

Frank explained Terry Blake has been maintaining the Quint Cemetery and he will continue to maintain it. Terry will let us know when he can't do it any longer.

Deb Tait asked for clarification from the referendum vote and also for case law regarding the situation. The Board said they will reach out to Zack.

Steve Booker asked when is he going to get a response to his e-mail, I said I believe that I did respond but I can give him a copy after this meeting. The letter with the tax bill \$440 should have been \$422,358.50.
