Selectmen's Meeting April 12, 2022

Selectmen in Attendance: William Flynn, Ricky Emery

5:30pm the meeting was called to order by Chair, William Flynn.

Minutes of April 5th were approved by Bill; seconded by Ricky. Vote 2-0-0.

FOAA Officer Resignation – The Board briefly discussed this and decided to table it until next week's meeting when the entire board could discuss.

Recreation Department – Willy would like to purchase a shed, at least 12'x16', to be able to store the lawn mower, hoses, etc. Ricky suggested checking with the Mennonites in Cornish to see if they have anything available. Willy reports that no information is on the well caps for either the town office or rec center. He is waiting on a quote from a well company to come out to determine the gallons per minute for each well to decide which would be best for using to irrigate the fields. Ricky asked about water testing at the rec and requested that Willy pick up a test kit and submit it ASAP. Ricky motioned to spend up to \$500 from the building capital improvement account to hire a company to test the well capacity/recovery; seconded by Bill. Vote 2-0-0. Ricky motioned to install an irrigation system, not to exceed \$14,000 from the building capital improvement account; seconded by Bill. Vote 2-0-0.

Spirit of America Award - Bill stated that Carol would like the Board to present the award at SMAC so that their staff can be included. Megan will reach out to Carol to schedule.

Federal Piping – Ricky asked if FP had left the manual for the boiler – Willy stated he has not received it yet. To Willy's knowledge, Dick has not completed the final walk through. Megan stated that FP is looking for the results of the walk through and the final payment.

Playground – Ricky requested that Willy get someone to inspect the playground and get a quote for any needed repairs.

6:18pm Bill motioned to adjourn the meeting; seconded by Ricky. Vote 2-0-0.
