Selectmen's Meeting October 13, 2020

5:30pm the meeting was called to order by Chair, William Flynn.

Minutes of October 7th were approved by Bill; seconded by Erik. Vote 3-0-0.

Cleaning bid – The board was in receipt of one sealed bid from Cindy Eaton. The Board unanimously decided to wait until after the budget vote on 10/21 to make any decisions so we know what budget we have to work with. Vincent Carbone offered to volunteer his time to clean the community center.

Food forest/community garden – Erik made a motion to allow Vincent Carbone to prepare for the food forest behind the town office between the rocks and tennis court to begin this fall; seconded by Ricky. Vote 3-0-0. Vincent said that 207 Permaculture is helping them with the design and they have begun a survey to get the community's feedback; Megan will add a link to the survey to the Town's website.

Abatement request – Megan spoke with a resident who has been being taxed for 2.25 acres, but her lot is only 1.1 acres via the deed. Bill motioned to approve an abatement for the difference in valuation plus interest for the last 3 years; seconded by Erik. Vote 3-0-0.

October 20 meeting – There will be no Selectmen's meeting on October 20th due to vacations.
