## Selectmen's Meeting September 14, 2021

5:30pm the meeting was called to order by Chair, William Flynn.

**Minutes** of August 31<sup>st</sup> were approved by Bill; seconded by Dick. Vote 3-0-0.

**Road Standards** – Deb presented the Board with the road standards that the Town paid HEB Engineers to do. It was voted on by the Board by was never presented to the Town for a vote; Deb asked for that to happen in the near future. Dick stated that there are some changes he would like to see for things he does not feel is fitting for Brownfield. Bill asked for it to be placed on an upcoming agenda so that we may move forward with necessary changes and to bring it to Town vote.

**Route 113/160 intersection** – A safety assessment of this intersection has been requested. Deb has also signed up for a speed sign for data collection for Spring 2022.

**American Rescue Plan** – Bill stated that Megan is in the process of setting up a portal user so we may access our funds.

**DEP Site Visit** – Athena Esponol from Maine DEP did a site visit at the transfer station, as she has just taken over our area. Bill thanked Cliff for attending the visit. Overall, she was pleased – we need to add an area for hot loads. Bill and Cliff will work on this and get the footprint updated.

**MMA Risk Management Visit** – John Waterbury from MMA Risk Management visited the Fire Station and Public Works. The Fire Station needed the rear stairs to come up to code, and Public Works had a number of issues to address.

**Recreation Department** – Willy stated that the skatepark fundraiser brought in \$552; Friends of Rec purchased pizza and drinks for the event. Soccer has begun; 35 kids from Brownfield are participating. Open gym nights have been successful so far with 15-20 people per night. He is beginning a calendar fundraiser for the month of October.

**BCC Heat** – Megan will put an invitation to bid for the replacement heating system at the Community Center.
