



## **SELECTMEN'S MEETING**

**DECEMBER 20, 2022**

### **MINUTES**

**Selectmen in Attendance:** Dick Norcross, Ricky Emery, and John Hicks.

Chairman, Dick Norcross called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM.

**Payroll and Accounts Payable Warrants** were approved.

**Minutes of the December 13, 2022 Selectmen's Meeting** were approved after Rick motioned, John second, and by unanimous vote.

Dick said that Cliff has a water leak at his house so he reported that Cliff plowed snow, plowed more snow, then plowed more snow and pushed trees out of the way. They did a pretty good job and everything was opened up yesterday and that CMP has the power back on. The report on the upcoming storm is ice, snow, rain, and wind, so it should be interesting.

Dicky reported we are off the list so the power should be back on for everyone. That our crew had two or three people out most of the night. Had to have Cliff open up a private driveway for an ambulance. He, himself couldn't actually go out but was able to dispatch the crew. He reported on a meeting with EMA regarding hazard mitigation. He said he worked with Wanda to secure the grant for the generator at the town garage and as soon as this is finished, he can put in an application for a generator for the Community Center so it could be used in a disaster as a warming shelter. Dick mentioned showers, also.

Rick reported that the State will be paving 113 starting with bids in March of next year; Our Assessor, Bob Konczal sent out letters; and, there is \$2,012.50 left in the election account.

Patrick reported they received proposals from 6 different companies. It will take time to get through them and they have another meeting tomorrow night. Patrick said Fryeburg and Denmark are concerned about having enough time to hold a referendum so may need to hold an open town meeting. They will probably be meeting every week for the next few months.

Dick reported that the head is bad on the red international. He was able to find a rebuilt for \$2,400 as opposed to \$10,000 for a new one.

With no other business Rick motioned, John second, and the meeting adjourned at 5:52 PM.
