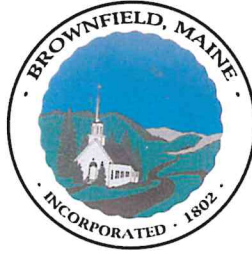

Selectmen's Meeting September 27, 2022 Minutes

At 5:35 PM the meeting was called to order by Rick Emery and the public hearing for adoption of the General Assistance Ordinance was opened for discussion and remained open throughout the meeting.

Payroll and Accounts Payable Warrants were signed.

Minutes: The Minutes of September 20, 2022 were approved.

Joe Egan explained that the town road standards were sent to the DOT to review. John explained that this should be reviewed with Cliff.

Rick reminded everyone that the Selectboard will not be meeting October 4th or October 11th but will be holding a workshop to set the tax rate on Wed, Oct 12th.

Patrick Bryant reported that Eastern Slopes Regional Broadband are inviting Select Board members to attend a meeting on October 19th at 6:00 PM at Molly Ockett. The purpose of the meeting is to update everyone on the progress so far.

Joe Egan unofficially reported that some members of the planning board have resigned but he is waiting until their next meeting to get official information on this. The Comprehensive plan

committee will have two informational meetings: Wed, October 26 and Mon, November 14th to hear what people have to say.

Bob McDonald of 422 Hampshire Road met to discuss high speed internet. Patrick said some people have bought Star Link for internet. Patrick said they are trying to get faster and to all houses in town.

Joe stated for one last thing, there are 8-10 people that meet to discuss problems/issues LG2003 public law the state took away home rule in an effort to create affordable housing.

Cindy reported that the food pantry is having their annual meeting on October 19th at 6:00 PM at the Lions Club. Everyone is welcome to come.
