## Selectmen's Meeting March 31, 2020

5:32pm the meeting was called to order by Chair, William Flynn.

**Minutes** of March 24<sup>th</sup> were approved by Bill; seconded by Erik. Vote 3-0.0

**Valley Pride Day** - Bill spoke with Donna who has emailed the Brownfield flyer for May 2<sup>nd</sup>. The Board unanimously decided to keep the date as of right now. Donna will supply bags, but it will be up to the residents to use their own gloves due to the shortage from COVID-19. Megan spoke with North Conway Incinerator who will drop off a dumpster May 1<sup>st</sup> at the Brownfield Community Center.

**Town Office Closure** - The original closure was for April  $7^{th}$  - Erik suggested going with the State guidelines and push it back to April  $30^{th}$  . The board unanimously decided to keep things the way they are until April  $30^{th}$  unless new things develop or requests from elected officials determine a change.

**Transfer Station Stickers** - Bill asked if the TS attendants can have a stack of TS stickers - Megan will email Michelle to ask her to give a stack to Joe tomorrow to people who are able to prove residency via their vehicle registration.

**Payables** - Bill acknowledged receipt of the payables; the Board unanimously approved them.

**Fire Department -** Dickie said they are having trouble getting PPE for their guys – specifically gloves and masks. Bill asked Dickie about the smoke detector program; he reports approximately 50 detectors have been installed before putting the program on hold due to COVID-19.

**Town Office Water Test** – The results of the town office water test are in; it passed all but Radon. Megan will post a sign by the outdoor faucet to let residents who use the water know. We are awaiting a quote to see how much it would cost to put in a water system to remove the radon.
