Selectmen's Meeting May 3, 2022

5:30pm the meeting was called to order by Chair, William Flynn.

Minutes of April 26th were approved by Bill; seconded by Ricky. Vote 2-0-0.

Phen Hill Fish Crossing Culvert- Cliff Cousins presented the service contract from Maine DEP to the selectmen.

Trees around the Rec Center – Cliff discussed having Jordan tree quote on removing trees around rec center. They are a danger to the wires, pavement and building at this point.

Roll Off shipping container – Cliff reiterated the need for a can and that the pricing ranges from \$5K- \$9K

Vehicle Registrations – Rick provided the Board with a letter from Denmark Town Manager, Betty LeGoff, stating they will no longer be willing to do registrations for the Town. What was supposed to be one week turned into two and it was too much for their staff. Question from zoom attendee as to whether Brownfield was online for registrations and it was answered that it is.

Broadband – Patrick Bryant attended- the selectmen accepted his recommendation and the team is now waiting for a contract to be presented and then for seven towns to sign on it so all systems are moving forward!

Transfer Station– New fee pricing was adopted May 1st but the cash register has not been updated for entry into the system so people being charged fees, are currently being charged the old ones.

Comprehensive Plan- Joe Egan asked if the Comprehensive Planning committee could man a table at the polls in June and the answer was yes and Patrick Bryant also stated he would do the same thing.

Balance Sheet- Joe Egan presented a “Combining balance sheet of Nonmajor Permanent Funds” to show what and where those balances were.

6:30 Selectboard went into Executive Session to discuss employee issues.

6:45pm Bill motioned to adjourn the meeting seconded by Ricky. Vote 2-0-0.
