



Brownfield Community Scholarship

The “Brownfield Community Scholarship” became an official non-profit group in 2007. The BCScholarship is organized exclusively for educational purposes to provide funds for the purchase of books, tools, or supplies necessary to pursue a student’s field of study.

There have been over 120 awarded since the scholarship was originally started in 1987 in Memory of Wirt Eaton.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Any current resident of Brownfield who is taking courses at a college, university, or school of higher learning is eligible to apply.

This means a high school senior, or entering sophomore, junior or senior year in college OR an adult learner who might be changing careers or taking classes to improve current employment.

Save your book, tool, or supply receipts, (refers to art, mechanic, photography, building, etc). After you receive your first semester grades, send them and your receipts to us. They will be reviewed and the award money will then be sent directly to you.
