Mail was reviewed from Jon Tanes who is requesting a recreational cannabis grow and retail license. Jon was sent information showing that town needs to "opt in" for the operation registered caregiver retail stores, registered dispensaries, testing facilities, and manufacturing facilities. The Town of Brownfield has not opted in.
