Snow Removal Policy

It is important that all plowed town roads be kept clear of obstructions for the proper removal of snow.

Obstructions left within town right of ways are there at the owner's risk. It is the obligation of all owners and occupants of property within the town to assure that no mailboxes, paper delivery boxes, signs or similar structures obstruct plowed rights-of-way. Any structure within the right-of-way exist there at the risk of the owner. Neither the town nor the road crews are responsible for damage caused to the structure by the plow.

Any vehicle parked on any road in the town, which is obstructing snow removal or sanding, shall be towed at the owner's expense.

The Town's Winter Roads Policy prohibits the plowing of snow across a roadway. No person shall throw, place or plow any snow or ice from private property onto any public street or road.
