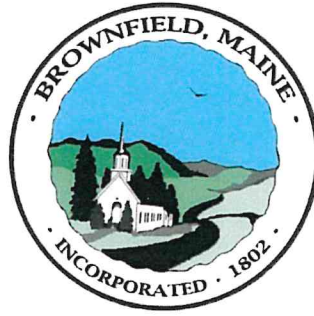

Town of Brownfield Winter Sand Use Policy

It is the policy of the Town of Brownfield that winter roadway sand will be available as a courtesy service to residents for use on residential walks and driveways. The winter sand is paid for by the Town of Brownfield and therefore is available to Town of Brownfield residents only. Residents will be granted reasonable access to the Public Works Department public sand containment area during normal business hours, and be allowed to fill 3 portable containers (5-gallon buckets or similar containers). Winter sand can be shoveled into and removed by pails.

Shoveling into truck beds, sanders or other large containers is not allowed. Any resident which avails themselves of this opportunity does so at their own risk and shall hold the Town harmless of any personal injury, equipment or vehicle damage which may occur as a result of their access to the public sand stockpile

A commercial operator, individual, contractor who maintains properties for a fee may not take any sand. Note: Saying they don't charge for sand does not qualify.

Any violations of this policy may result in permanent denial of access to courtesy sand from the Town and will be reported to Oxford County Sheriff Department.
